GENERAL REMARKS

The general standard of work is satisfactory and there is ample evidence of careful preparation and planning on the part of brothers and teachers. However the following observations are apposite:

- Religious Training: a. Prayers need more careful attention.  
 b. Devotional practices (scapulars, rosary) should be fostered.  
 c. Christian Politeness should receive appropriate attention in each class.
- Nature Study does not appear as Grade V programme.
- Singing, Speechcraft, Physical Education should receive more attention.
- Spelling is weak in all Primary and lower Secondary Classes. A practical remedy should be applied.
- Home Exercises should be dated and signed by a parent, and corrected effectively by the teacher.
- Science accommodation is inadequate and unsatisfactory in view of modern needs: thought should be given to possible improvements.
