GENERAL REMARKS

The boys of this school impress by their manly bearing, their interest and spontaneity and the evident regard they have for their school and its standards. Their attitude at prayer and their ability to answer doctrinal questions and to engage in discussion of religious topics are commendable.
 The new school wing has greatly enhanced the facilities of the school and has been used to good effect by the seniors. The improvement in the Grade V room may well extend to the other Primary classes as the Primary Subsidy becomes available each year. There is need for a library for the use of the younger boys, especially in view of the very high percentage of new Australians in the school. The weakness of Grade VI is being faced realistically by the Class Teacher with good results anticipated.
 The policy with respect to the development of further secondary streams to provide wider choice of subjects, & better use of staff and facilities must be considered in the near future.
