GENERAL REMARKS

SECONDARY SUBJECTS TAUGHT

The headmaster and staff are to be commended for the high level of organization and efficiency, for the enthusiastic, competent teaching, and for the friendly relationship apparent between pupils and teachers.

The school has some splendid material features in science laboratories and classrooms, but is lacking two essential units in a school's design - a properly equipped library of suitable dimension and the necessary multi-purpose rooms. The former is of major urgency in the light of the emphasis placed today on reading and resource centres in educational planning. The senior students are able to select from the wide range of ten subjects; but unfortunately Maths I is not offered as an alternative to Maths II + III, the latter really belonging to those with a special aptitude for Mathematics.

The Achievement Certificate is being smoothly introduced into the lower secondary classes.
